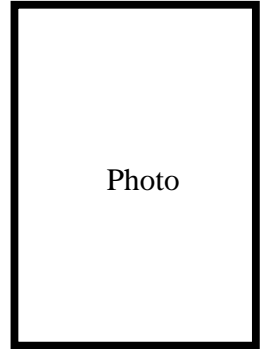

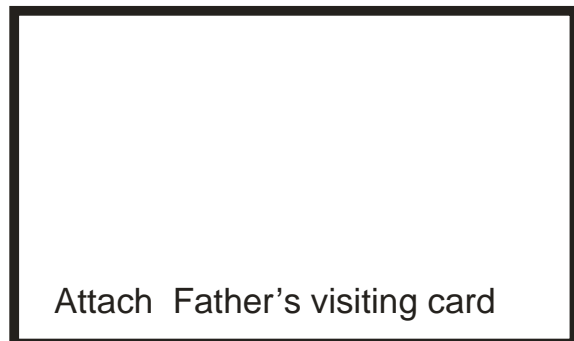

Rules and Regulations

1. Fee includes design aptitude test, general aptitude test, studio test/ situation test, group discussion and basic portfolio preparation for NID/NIFT/CEPT and other design colleges. (According to the examination pattern of colleges)
2. Professional portfolio for foreign study is different from basic portfolio.
3. Each student is supposed to sign the attendance register whenever he/ she come for the class.
4. Student should read notice board daily for the latest updates (For e.g. Information regarding form availability, last date of submission of forms etc.)
5. Cost of study material and stationary is to be borne by the student for design aptitude test and situation /studio test (e.g. Colors, papers, pencils or xerox copy etc.)
6. If institute declares holiday due to any reason then extra class will be provided by the institute and student will be informed through SMS or by phone on the phone no. provided by the candidate to the institute in the registration form, in case your phone no. gets changed then you are supposed to inform the institute.
7. There will be revision classes before every entrance exam for 10 days, these classes are not compulsory but if student attends them, it will be good for him/her. For revision classes time setting will be on first come first basis.
8. During revision classes students appearing for next year will have holidays for 10 days.
9. There will be 25 to 30 students in week day's batch and 35 to 40 students in week end batches.
10. We are not promising 100% admission in the colleges/institute selected.
11. We do not give any type of certificate or diploma; this is a personal tuition centre for entrance exam preparation.
12. The candidate is required to complete 75 hrs module in one year time period or can complete the same under crash course module of different time durations (mentioned in crash course module section). After completion of 75 hrs module the student is required to come for the revision classes that will be conducted for 10 days before the selected entrance exam.
13. This fee structure is for entrance exam preparation of one college, the student can prepare for another three colleges under this fee structure.
14. In case of more than 4 colleges Rs.5, 000/- per college entrance exam preparation will be charged.
15. The preparation classes will end from the time the student gets selected in one college mentioned by the student in the registration form.
16. Fees for 75 hrs OR 75 exercises is Rs. 16,500/- plus 10.3% service tax for year 2010, fees for entrance exam preparation for year 2011 is Rs.18, 500/- plus 10.3% service tax.
17. Fees for crash course is Rs. 18,500/- plus 10.3% service tax for year 2011.
18. Cost of correspondence course is Rs. 5,000/- .
19. For 8th, 9th, 10th and 11th standard students- if student wants to continue next year then fees Rs. 10,000/- will be charged for 2nd year and so on.
20. BRDS reserves the right to change regulations at any time as per requirements as also revise the tuition fees, and other fees and charges as deemed fit. Such changes of regulations would be put on the notice board.
21. **Fees once paid is not refundable.** (Even under the following cases also fees will not be refunded)
 - a) If your admission form for entrance exam to institute selected gets rejected due to any reason, BRDS is not responsible for that rejection.
 - b) All colleges have certain age limit and minimum qualification requirement for admission, kindly check the age and qualification requirements of the institutes or colleges with the prospectus or at their relevant websites or with their administration department, any rejections in admission due to age and qualification limit will not be the responsibility of BRDS .
 - c) If 12th board examination result of the student comes negative, due to which student does not gets admission to design college, BRDS is not responsible for that failure.
 - d) If any wrong information is provided by the candidate in the registration form, BRDS reserves the right to cancel the admission at studio.
 - e) Smoking, consumption of alcohol and drug abuse is prohibited within the BRDS campus. If student is found indulging in such activities, BRDS will cancel student's admission.
 - f) Student is expected to respect faculties, visitors, students, employees and others connected with the design studio. Any misbehavior with faculties, employees and students will not be tolerated at studio. The studio has the right to cancel student's admission if student is observed misbehaving.
 - g) If you quit the course due to any personal reasons, in that case also fees is not refundable.

26. In case application forms to be filled are missed by the student, BRDS is not responsible for that. It is student's responsibility to check with the studio when the forms will be available for the admission to design colleges.
27. Student can change the timing of classes according to their other tuition timings.
28. Time can be changed monthly. Time will be changed only if seat is available in the batch to which the student wants to get transferred.
29. Daily timings will not be changed.
30. Student is required to come on the specified time according to time table.
31. For second phase i.e. studio test/situation test and portfolio preparation the time will be set by studio.
32. If you have any queries or doubts kindly visit the studio with appointment.
